- Club membership fee (\$250) is due for payment by the end of July. Send payment to Bob MacGillivray. The membership fee must be paid separate from any other payments.

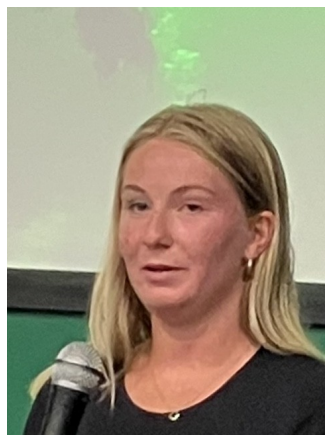
-Larry Neely has been made an Honorary Life Member of the Nutana Club. Congratulations and thanks for your service Larry!
