He became a Medical Officer at a teaching hospital. Bob became a Rotarian while attending university and was involved with the polio eradication program.

Bob came to Saskatchewan to get his Masters in Public Health. In Saskatoon he met Brynn who invited him to join our club. Bob is currently looking for employment and his goal is to live a meaningful life.

Zibah Saluadeen

Zibah was born into a Muslim polygamous family in eastern Nigeria. His birthplace was Kaduna City but he livid and took up to Grade 7 in a village. Due to family circumstances he finished the rest of his schooling, including University at boarding school. He is a single father three children and converted to Christianity.

Zibah is a Chartered Accountant and has an MBA. He has extensive experience in accounting and information technology. He came to Canada in 2021 to start a new life.

Zibah first encountered Rotary in University as a Rotoractor, did some volunteer work with Rotary and joined Rotary in Nigeria in 2017.
