1. **Cow Plop Bingo Fundraiser** – presented by Karol Komar and Candace Odishaw

MAIN FEATURE (1-3 cows possibly)

- Tickets 1000 to be sold this year: \$15 single tickets or 4 for \$50 (800 tickets at 4 for \$50 – 200 sets) and remainder (200 tickets) sold as single tickets (SLGA has to know the breakdown of sales). Tickets will be able to be purchased on line or in person from Club members. Note: There is no kid’s price.
- Candace has talked to the school and they are in agreement along with the4 school board.

- Candace has sent an email to the Community Association (who handles the rink) – their next meeting is March 9th. We will need to wait until then for full approval and confirmation of the date and whether we are able to have up to 3 cows on the property.
- We need to decide what cause we want this fundraiser dedicated to.
- She is contacting CJWW again to be the judge for “the deed”.
- Candace has contacted Robin Bellamy who loans BBQs to service clubs for free and has booked a BBQ for the event.
- The big winner prize will be \$2000. (If we sell all 1000 tickets we earn \$13,000).
- Candace explained about a possible subdraw: Barrels A. B. C. Participants decide which barrel they want to place their ticket (1 barrel for each cow). The winning ticket would then be drawn from that barrel – Bovine A, B, or C, depending upon which cow plops. If no cow plops in the designated hour, additional rules will be added to choose a winner.

Candace will keep the club posted by emails as planning progresses and people can sign up for their volunteer shifts
