Betty Ann led the singing of “O Canada” and the “Four Way Test Song”

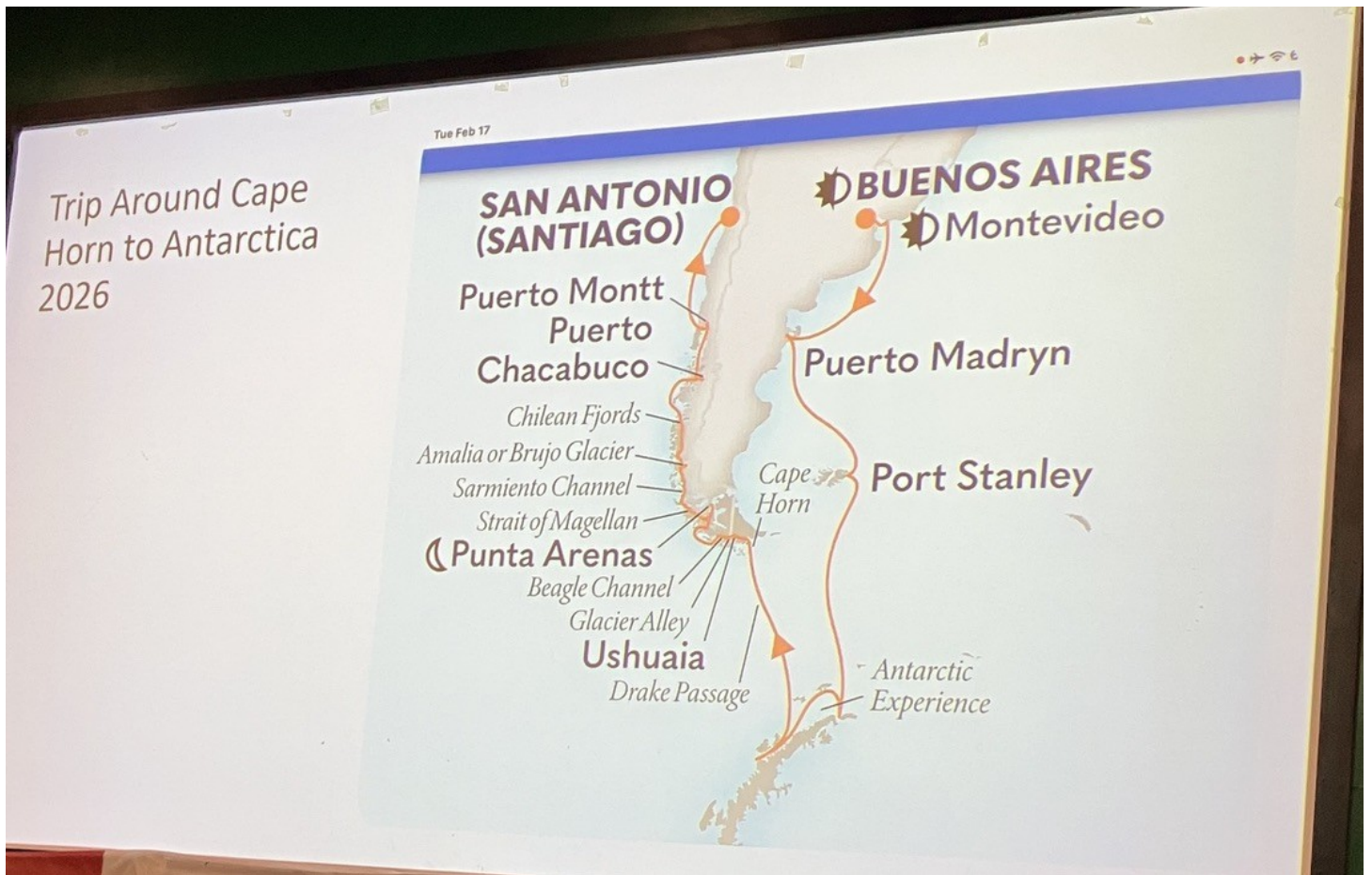
ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Walt noted the passing of Dixie Fisher, wife of former club member Don Fisher

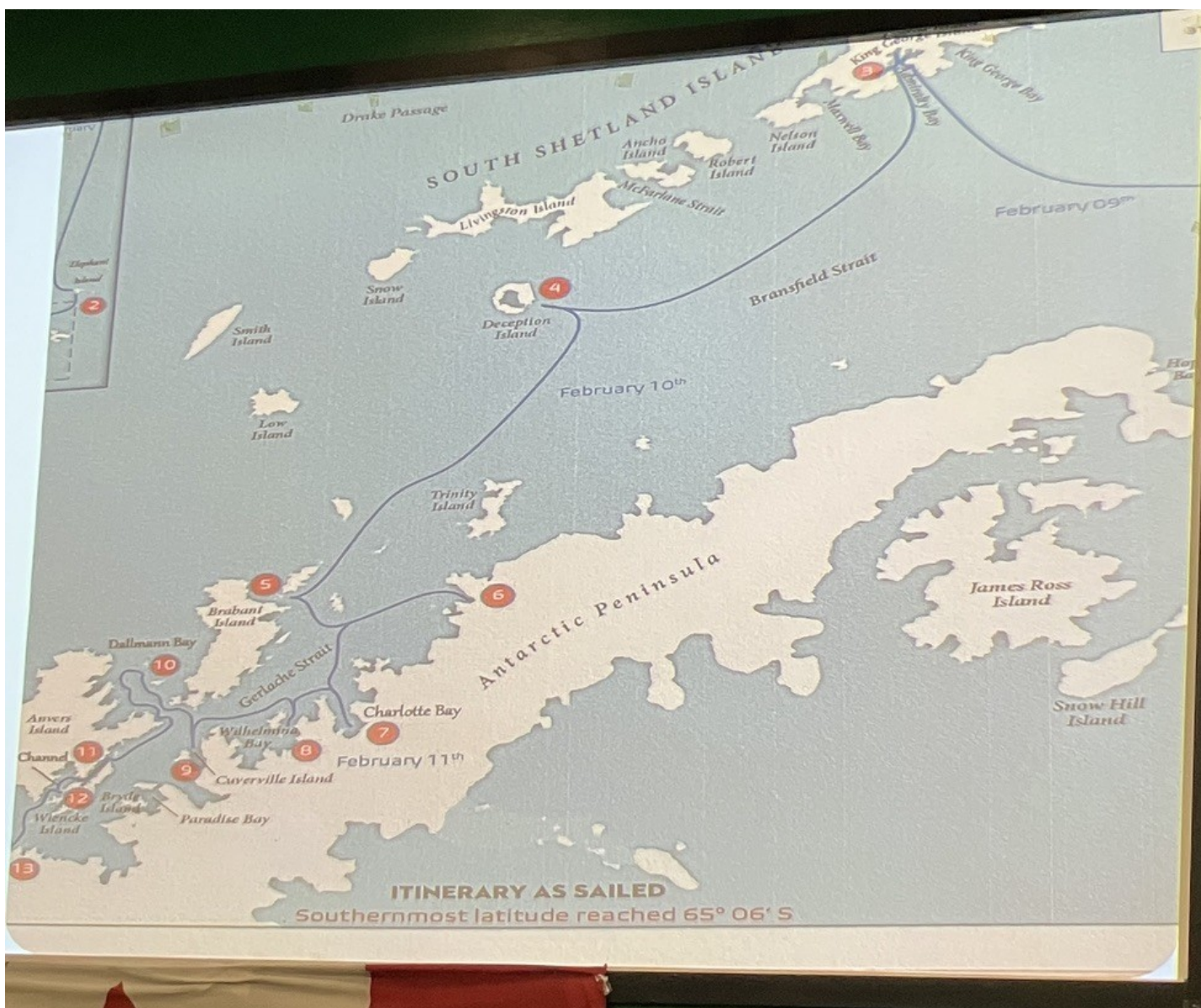
PROGRAM

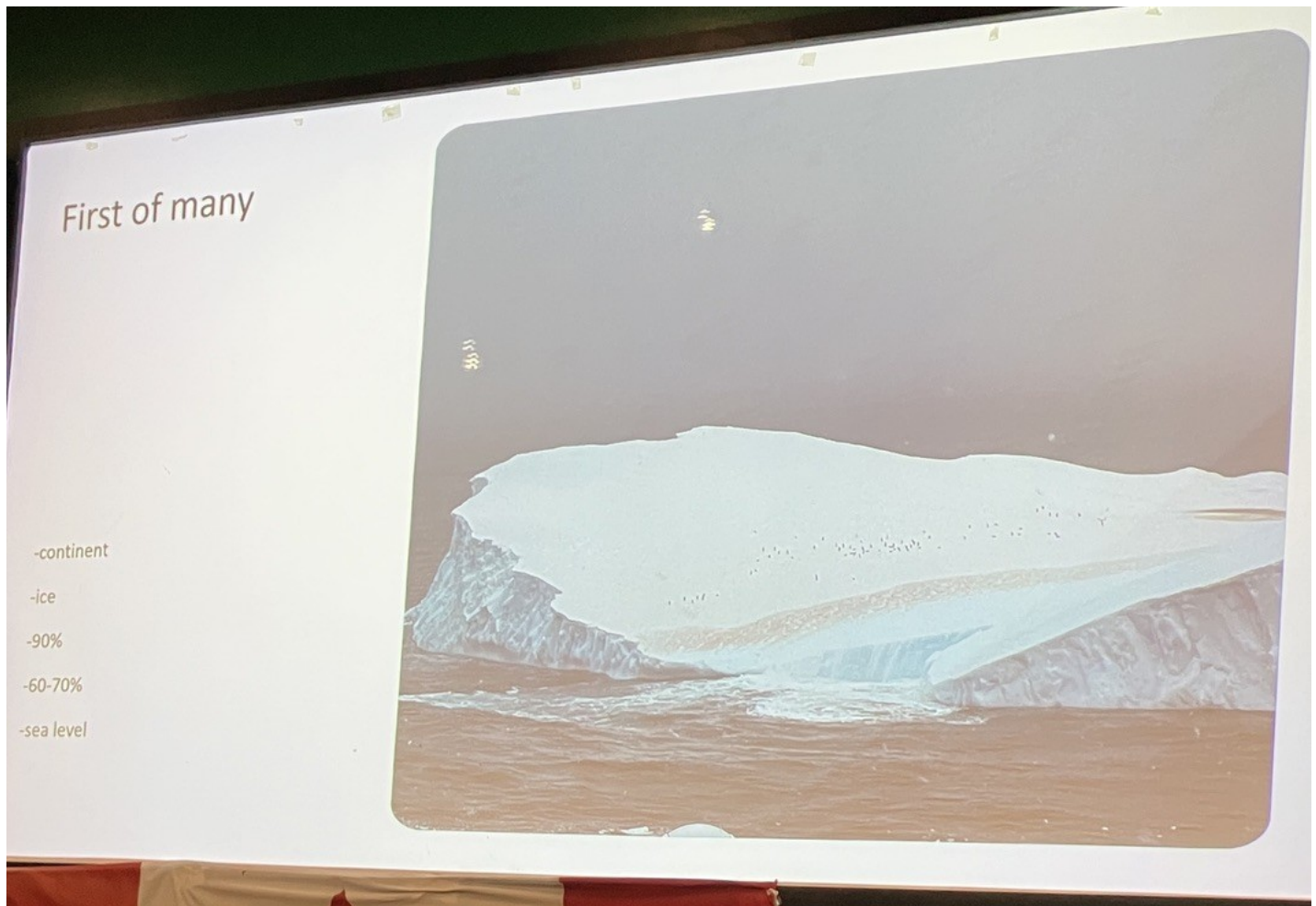
