Jim Blackburn introduced Bev Dubois as our speaker. Bev is a graduate of Usask and is serving her 5th term as a city Councillor. Bev has served on numerous local, civic, provincial and national Boards, Commissions and Committees. In her working life she has held executive positions with the Meewasin Foundation, the Canadian Digital Network, SREDA and Ernst and Young.

Bev's contributions to the betterment of society have been recognized by being a recipient of the Saskatchewan Centennial Medal and the Queens Diamond and Platinum Jubilee Medals.

Bev is a member of the Saskatoon Rotary Club.



Bev spoke to a number of issues now facing City Council

- Budget Bev feels the approved mill rate increase for 24-25 is too high and more should have been done to reduce it. Council should concentrate on core service, cannot afford non-essentials.
- Downtown Entertainment District The main issue for Bev are the costs and how they can be contained. Presently an RFP has been issued for private partners.
- Housing the city has received \$41.3 m over the next 10 years from the federal government for the incentivized construction of about 1,000 homes.
- Snow Removal Bev was pleased with the response by the city crews to the 55cm prolonged snowfall in early March. The goals for timing of snow clearing were largely met.
- Reconciliation the city is being recognized for its positive efforts in this area.
