Candace Odishaw introduced our speaker Heaven Knife. Candace met Heaven at her work place when Heaven was there to purchase furnishings. During the sales process Candace go to know Heaven and was so taken by her life story that she asked Heaven to come and speak to our club.

Heaven told of her life and experiences as a child in a dysfunctional home. She witnessed her Mothers attempted suicide when she was 10 years old. This trauma initiated a destructive life style that included an abusive relationship, addiction, life in foster care, runaways and a near death experience. Ultimately Heaven recognized she needed help and found treatment for her addiction. She currently has been drug and alcohol free for 4 years and 7 months.

With her addiction issue under control Heaven has been able to complete her Grade 12 and just recently got her learners license.

Through counselling and therapy Heaven was set on the path of self discovery.

Heaven was able to access the YWCA Turning Points Program which offers hope for women in similar circumstances as Heaven. Heaven feels this program was a key in her being able to recover and begin her life anew.
