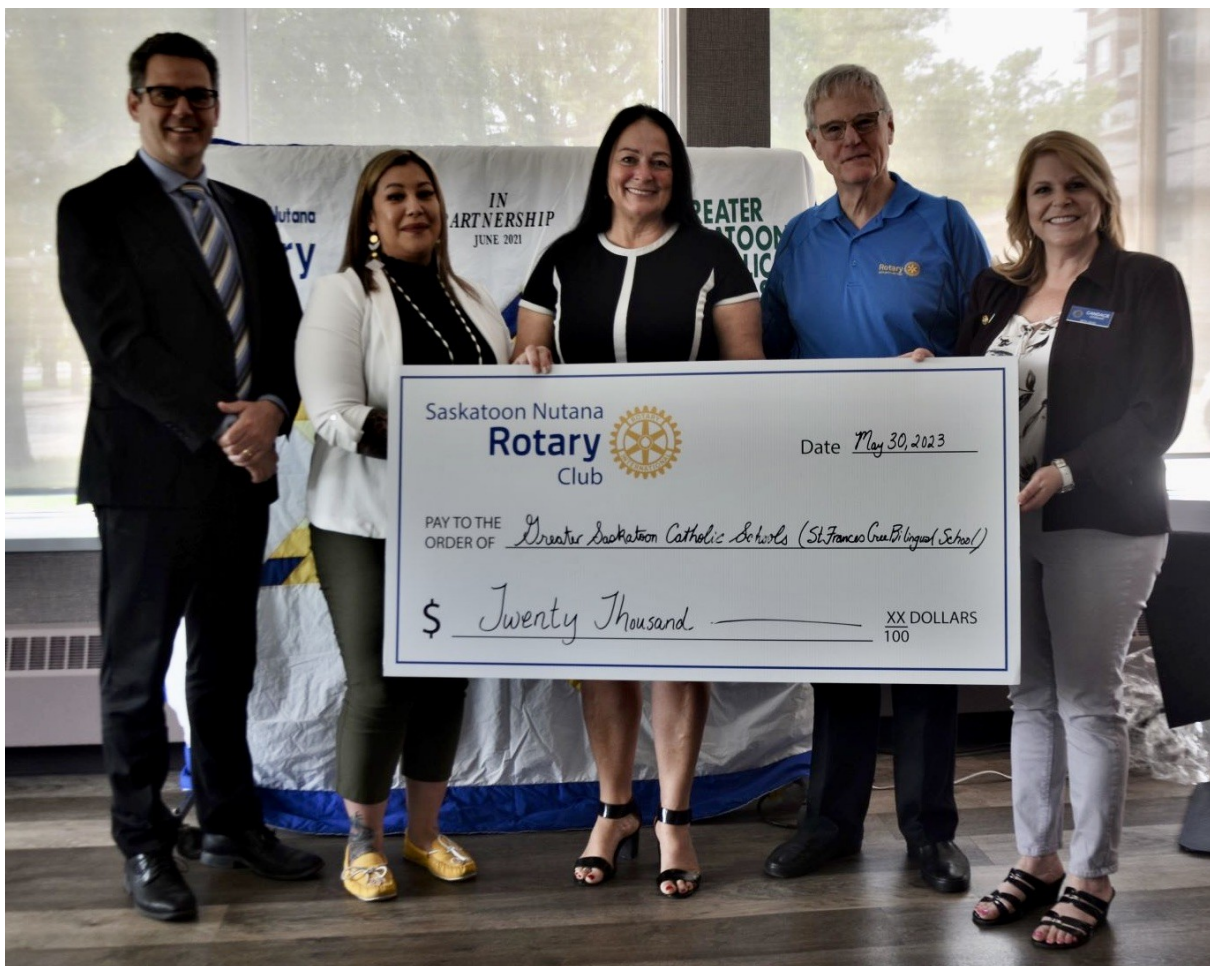
We were reminded that we are on Treaty 6 territory and land of the Metis.

On June 25th 2021 a Memorandum of Understanding was signed between the Nutana Rotary Club and the Greater Saskatoon Catholic School Board and in particular St. Frances Cree Bilingual School. Over recent years our club has made a major effort to address the Truth and Reconciliation Report's Calls to Action. Our commitment in the MOU not only funding but an on going working relationship with the students, educators and administrators at the school. These relationships are what reconciliation is about. Jim Gillis expanded on this relationship and with Candace made the cheque presentation. The \$20,000 cheque is the second instalment of a five year commitment by the club.



The Saskatoon Indian Metis Friendship Centre is a corporate member of the Nutana Rotary Club. Our collaboration with SIMFC has allowed us to be involved in addressing the issues of homelessness and food security in Saskatoon. Jim Gillis told us more about this collaboration and with Candace presented a cheque for \$3500 to SIMFC
