Candace indicated that our Speaker Nadera Batori would be telling her life story and would not need an introduction.

Nadera arrived in Canada as a refugee from Afghanistan in August of 2022. She is a member of the Hazari ethnic group. The Hazari have been marginalized by the rest of the population. Nadera's village was destroyed by a group of nomads called the Kochi and the Hazari had to relocate to safety in Marefat. It was in Marefat that

Nadera was able to continue her education and start to realize her dreams of a career in the medical sciences. Then her father passed away suddenly and Nadera had to discontinue her education so she could work to help support the family.

On August 15, 2021 the Taliban took control of Afghanistan and installed their government. The Taliban were particularly repressive towards women by restricting their rights for an education and requiring the wearing of a hijab while in public. Nadera couldn't tolerate these condition and decided to escape from Afghanistan.

After many delays and harrowing experiences she arrived in Canada in August 2022. She left behind her Mother and siblings and is working toward bringing her family to Canada to reunite.

Asit advised that the Mennonite Central Committee(MCC) is the sponsor for the Batori family and will only be a sponsor for a group of 3. MCC has created a Trust Fund for depositing donations for the family to be used for their first year of residence in Canada. MCC is seeking \$53,000 Cdn for support of the family.

Lorne Braithwaite thanked the speaker for her presentation and courage.

CHEER CAPTAIN

Zubin from the Open Door Society was Cheer Captain. Peggy said that all funds raised today would be donated to the MCC Trust Fund in aide of Nadera's family. Zubin quizzed the club with pop culture questions which were all answered because the club is so old and wise.
