- 2. All clues are accessible by vehicle however you may choose to get out and walk at some clue locations. Please ensure that social distancing is being maintained to protect yourself and others.
- 3. Please E-transfer your \$20 to <u>nutanarotary@hotmail.com</u>. In the message of your E-transfer, put your **full name** (1 name per entry) and **your email address.** Without this, we cannot forward you the clues! (if you are unable to e-transfer, please contact us and we can figure out an alternate payment method if need be). Use "Rotary" if using a password in your E-Transfer.
- 4. The Scavenger Hunt will run from 10am to 6 pm on June 21, 2020.
- Your instructions will be emailed to you at 9:30 am on June 21st. Should you not receive your instructions by 10 am on June 21st, please email to nutanarotary@hotmail.com.
- 6. You will receive 10 descriptions for historical locations within Saskatoon. Once you determine where these locations are, you will need to drive to each location. You are welcome to use google to help find these locations.
- 7. At each location you will find a Rotary Scavenger Hunt poster with a letter on it. This letter is your clue. Collect all 10 of these to solve the ultimate puzzle. The answer is a proper name, two words. The name is someone that is honoured within the Rotary community. You will need to unscramble the 10 clues and again, they are in no particular order.
