Since 1999, Alan has acted as agent for transactions totaling over \$100 million and has completed a number of initial public offerings and co-created; 49 North Resource Fund. Alan has a number of industry designations and has been active in the industry serving on the Investment Dealers Association district council and was a national director of the Investment Industry Association of Canada.
