Principles of Rotary in Business

Gary Rusu introduced John Cross who is no stranger to many members in the club. John trained as a chemical engineer and has had an interesting career with stops in many companies including Labatts, the POS Pilot Plant, and Philom-Bios (now known as Novozymes Inc.)

John shared his thoughts on "keys to success" and how Rotary's Four Way Test plays a crucial role. "It's all about people things", he began. Hire the right people - "why would you buy a dog and bark yourself?" According to John, the following are success factors:

- Change is mandatory, survival is optional. Choose wisely.
- It's not what we think, it's how we think.
- Our sole purpose is to create wealth, and wealth comes in many forms.
- It's all about attitude.
- Integrity is mandatory and priceless. It's earned with difficulty and lost with ease.
- If you tell the truth, you don't have to remember anything.
- Execute, execute, execute get things done!

He concluded by stating that the Four Way Test is the "lighthouse that guides us in making the right choices."
