A celebration of our Rotary Restorative Action Program

Peter Whitenect began the meeting by thanking all of the Rotary Restorative Action Program (RRAP) funders in the audience. He offered thanks to the Community Initiatives Fund which has been a main funder of RRAP for many years. He also thanked Affinity Credit Union for their long time support and belief in RRAP.

Superintendent of Education Gord Martell and principal of Bethlehem Catholic High School, Scott Gay, thanked Rotary and all of the community partners for their support.

Bethlehem RRAP worker Darren Bowman then took to the podium and spoke of the difference the program is making at his school. RRAP is in its third year at Bethlehem. Over 70 cases have been dealt with. RRAP offers an effective way to deal with conflict, said Bowman. "Conflict resolution is not about a quick fix or a bandaid solution. It's a real change in behaviour. It's all about listening."

In the beginning most of the referrals to the program were coming from school administrators. Now almost 50% of referrals are coming directly from students. The program is truly making a difference at the school. Thank you Rotary!
