The membership passed a resolution that the number of Directors of the corporation be dropped from seven to five. The resolution was passed. Both Clare and **President Wayne** reminded members that we need a treasurer for the Trust Fund. Here's the job description:

- receive donations and proceeds of special events and issue receipts

- attend to payment of expenses and distribution of donated funds
- maintain accounting system using Quickbooks accounting software
- reconcile cash, bank, investment and other accounts as required on a monthly basis
- prepare financial reports (using Quickbooks) as required for the World Community Service Committee, Project Leaders and the Rotary Club of Saskatoon Board of Directors
- serve as an ex-officio member of the World Community Service Committee and attend committee meetings as often as possible.

## Vocational Talk

**Kathy Weber** gave us a glimpse into her life, both personally and professionally. She began by describing herself as a farm kid from Saskatchewan who learned her work ethic and the importance of a healthy balance between life and work from her parents.

She spent almost 25 years with Co-operative Trust (now Concentra Financial) working in the area of corporate trusts. During that time she worked as a consultant with Revenue Canada and with various pension commissions across the country. She is an expert in RRIF's RESP's, and RRSP's. About five years ago she decided to leave Concentra and join the group of family companies - Weber Financial Planning Group, Kajan Consulting and the land development side of the business. She also currently serves as chair of the Saskatchewan Rate Review Panel.

Kathy concluded her talk by noting the Rotary "adds such dimension to everything she does." She thanked all members for the opportunity to serve.
