Programma de Becas

President Wayne McGillivray introduced **Jim** and **Kathy Weber** who provided us with the latest news on Programma de Becas. The Webers last visited the Rotary Club of Puerto Vallarta Sur in January of this year. Jim attended three regular Club meetings and three Board meetings. He and Kathy were able to witness the presentation at the University of Puerto Vallarta on January 22nd of scholarships to 19 of the 26 students receiving support from the program. These students are sponsored as a direct result of personal donations made by members of our club. Jim and Kathy noted that each student had to sign a commitment form to the program as they received their cheque. A student must have an 80% average to qualify for the program and maintain that average throughout the program.

Education is provided free of cost up to grade seven in Mexico. From that point on, the education costs are paid for by the family of the student. This is why the Becas Program is so important and why these students and the members of the Rotary Club of Puerto Vallarta Sur could not say enough to express their thanks and appreciation

for the support provided by our club. If the parents of a 12 or 13 year old child cannot afford the costs of a continued education, that child is expected to go to work. Kathy noted that sponsoring a young person helps the child go to school, but it also helps the entire family, financially and emotionally.

Jim shared with us the certificate presented by the President of the Rotary Club of Puerto Vallarta Sur, expressing appreciation to the members of our club for their financial support. Numerous members of our club have given financial support to the Programma de Becas and the students being supported are most grateful to our members for making such a positive change in their lives.

Kathy and Jim described one of the schools they visited. The school library displayed student's academic and athletic trophies, but the books were totally inadequate. There was a computer room, but most of the computers were not working. The school did have manual typewriters. Kathy noted that while more books and computers would be helpful, the best assistance we can give to a student would be to tutor them in English. And more scholarships would be beneficial to support other students in need.

President Wayne McGillivray extended our club's sincere thanks and appreciation for the work Jim and Kathy are providing to the Becas Program and noted that a donation would be made to the Salvation Army Bethany Home in recognition of their presentation.

Masters Golf Pool

Dave Sundby introduced Simone Lightbody, the winner of this year's Masters Golf Pool. Dave presented Simone with a cheque for \$5,000. Cheques were also presented to members **Don Somers** for a 4th place finish and **Clare Heagy** for a 6th place finish. Dave noted that our club earned just under \$5,000 with this fundraiser.
