University of Saskatchewan Alumni Association

Peter Zakreski introduced Jason Aebig, president of the University of Saskatchewan Alumni Association. Jason provided a succinct and informative presentation on the history of the association and its role in today's society.

The University of Saskatchewan Alumni Association began in 1917 as the "Graduates Association". It changed its name in 1939. The Association has 135,000 members worldwide, with 31,800 living in Saskatoon. Alumni live in 117 different countries, with three out of four living in Canada, and almost 50% living in Saskatchewan. 1,000 new members were added to the Association at this fall's recent convocation.

Some of the services offered by the Alumni Association include alumni reunions, a travel program, an affinity credit card, and the Green and White alumni magazine.

Jason posed the question: How can alumni help the University? He spoke about four areas:

1. Reputation building
2. Giving
3. Volunteering
4. Celebrating (our own)

Jason concluded his remarks by reminding members that "who we are, what we've done, and the impact we have made", is forefront in the work of the Association.
