**Introduced by Peter Zakreski**

- Outstanding leader
- Chief of Whitecap First Nation since 1985 - in his 7<sup>th</sup> term
- Whitecap employs about 650 people and continues to thrive
- Received Order of Merit in 2011

**Chief Bear's comments:**

- 125<sup>th</sup> anniversary of treaty with Canada
- Ancestors helped the nation of Canada
- Population - 2000 - 385; 2005 - 467
- Resources -
  - ⊙▪ about 5000 ac. of land
  - ⊙▪ 25 km south of Saskatoon - same location since 1879
  - ⊙▪ Good relationship with Saskatoon since 1882
  - ⊙▪ Population - 385 in 2000, 467 in 2000

**Responsible governance through accountability, transparency, community communication, advisory committee, Council compensation commission**  
**Legislation - Laws and Policies - examples**

- First Nation Land Management Act
- Development and servicing agreements
- Matrimonial real property law
- Law respecting traditional interests
- Environmental management agreement
- Self Government agreement
- Tri-partite policing agreement
- Taxes and fees - e.g., community improvement fee, liquor consumption fee
- Provincial fuel and tobacco tax agreement
- Surveyed road maps to enable street names and house numbers
- Land leasing - up to 49 yr commercial leases and 99 year residential leases - facilitates home and business ownership
- Water treatment plants
- New public works building
- Chief Whitecap Park (1979) - 320 ac. - partnership with Saskatoon
- Business, education, recreation developments - Dakota Dunes Golf, Whitecap Trail gas bar, hotel, bison ranch, business park, school expansion, new health centre, day care, fire and police protection
