Guest Speaker - Dale Brin, CEO, Saskatoon Express

Dale started in the newspaper industry at age 15 in Moose Jaw. He moved many times with Thompson newspaper interests throughout Canada - each of his 4 children was born in a different province. His last stop was the Star Phoenix from which he 'retired' at age 54, but 'unretired' 2 months later to launch a new weekly city paper.

He recalled many instances when newspapers were declared 'dead'. But, they have survived all of the technological changes - radio, TV, internet. Like red wine - an acquired taste.

Success criteria - Readers produce results, thus it is important to keep content current and engaging. Locals involved include Cam Hutchinson, Tammy Roberts, Ned Powers, Betty-Ann Heggie and more. Print product remains the core business, but have expanded on-line. They have a business plan and are following it. They have no debt and expect to break even in their first year.

The paper is printed in Wainwright because of access to special technology. Distribution costs to households - \$50 K+. It will remain a free publication. Copies can be obtained at some locations, if mail delivery does not occur - locations can be found online.

Our Exchange Students, Andreas and Mely, gave us an overview of their year. They had recently participated in a trip to Nipawin and have many more events planned before their year is finished.
