Biography:

Mayor Atchison was first elected to Saskatoon City Council in 1994 and served as councilor up to his election as Mayor in 2003. He was re-elected as Mayor in 2006 and again in 2009.

Growing up in Saskatoon, "Atch" was involved in a variety of activities. He especially loved sports, where his talent as a hockey goaltender led to playing in the professional leagues. After hockey, he returned to Saskatoon and his family's retail business. He and his wife Mardele have remained in Saskatoon, where they have raised five children.

Mayor Atchison believes family and teamwork are essential principles in his role as Mayor. He strives to see all sides of the issues, to work in partnership to create the greatest benefit for all citizens of Saskatoon.

Keeping you finger on the pulse of a growing city like Saskatoon is a full-time job. Mayor Atchison has been a member of almost every Board and Committee of City Council. He has attended over 10,000 meetings and public events as Mayor.

In recognition of his work, Mayor Atchison has received a number of honors, including being named a Paul Harris Fellow of the Rotary Foundation of Rotary International; Medal of Merit by the International Association of Lions Clubs; the Consumer Choice "Man of the Year" Award; and the Canadian Sport Tourism Alliance President's Award for Public Sector Supporter.

Presentation Highlights:

His Worship's presentation focused on the Remail Art Gallery and River Landing. He was kind enough to share with us the same information that was presented to the city council !!!

Other Presentation Notes:

- Local fundraising has yielded approximately \$17 of the required \$20M
- The Remai Art Gallery facility will allow for travelling exhibits that the Mendel Gallery can't accommodate
- There will be no regular admission fees to the new facility, however certain special exhibits may require admission fees
- There have been many key investors that have provided both capital and operating funds
- After the new facility is completed it is proposed that the existing Mendel Gallery be converted into a children museum. This would be in conjunction to renovation and upgrades to the Kinsmen Park area as well
