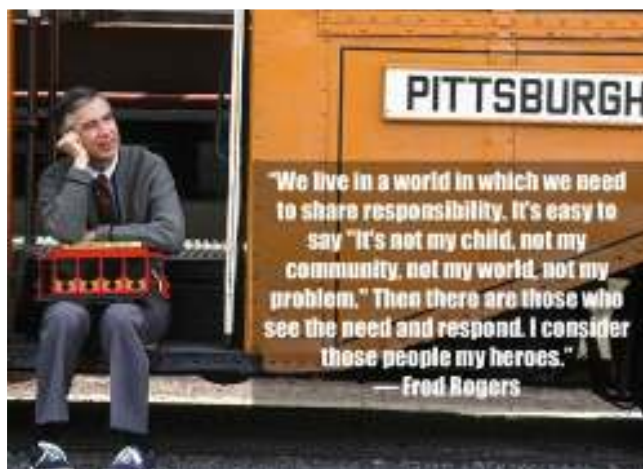

Rotary Facts and Trivia

The four way test was created by Rotarian Robert J. Taylor in 1932 when he was asked to take charge of the Chicago based Club Aluminum Company, which was facing bankruptcy. Taylor looked for a way to save the struggling company mired in depression - caused financial difficulties. He drew up a 24 word code of ethics for all employees to follow in their business and professional lives.

Herb Taylor became a president of Rotary International during 1954-55. The Four Way test was adopted by Rotary in 1943 and has been translated into more than 100 languages.

Earle's career has been in the field of education where he has served in the Saskatchewan Public School System as a teacher, a principal and the director of personnel. While at the University of Saskatchewan he served as the Department head in Educational Administration where he focused on school improvement, leadership and change processes.

Earle has served in Rotary since 1976. He has been a member of the Saskatoon, Regina Eastview, Vancouver North and Saskatoon North clubs. During which time he was the District 5550 Chair of World Community Service, working with projects in Argentina, Uganda, Zambia, the Congo and is currently a monitor and evaluator for the Canadian Rotary Collaboration for International Development and assigned to Mozambique in 2011, Belize in 2012. He is a Paul Harris fellow and a member of the Bequest Society. Earle is currently a member of Saskatoon North Rotary.

Earle has 2 children, 6 grandchildren including 24 year old triplets. His interests are enjoying the Meewasin Trail, reading, golf, skiing, travel and the Rough Riders.
