Our speaker was Bryn Boback Lane, President and CEO of the Children's Hospital Foundation. Bryn pointed out there was wide community support in the Province for the Hospital. She mentioned in passing that our Brian H. was a Board member. The drive for a hospital for children started some time ago. A group sought the help of Paul Martin from Regina in getting a strategic plan established in 1999. This provided a strong basis for moving ahead. The new Hospital would not try to duplicate the very special pediatric care already available in other Canadian centres but would concentrate on providing general pediatric care in a setting suitable for the age group 0-18 years. Labour and maternity wards would be included in the three-floor building. Each patient would have a private room with natural light and a view. Special areas will be provided for families. There may be provision for a helicopter pad.
