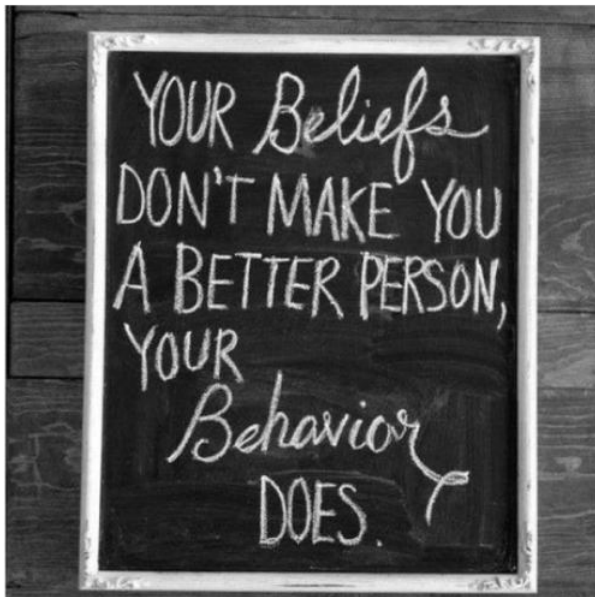
Health of the Club
