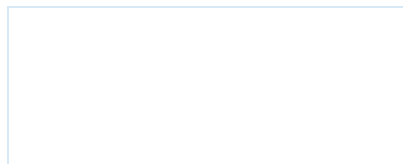

Jim reported that the word "becas" means "scholarship". PV south Rotary club is directly in the Becas program, the founding of which was driven by the reality that in Mexico by ag education is no longer free. Uniforms which are compulsory, supplies, etc. cost a lot comp incomes and the Becas program offsets these costs. It also encourages kids to stay in sch Saskatoon members currently sponsor students. Wally and Colleen Mah, local Saskatoon entrepreneurs are also sponsoring students now. The program takes kids through from gr seven to university entrance age

Kathy and PV members Carmen and Pedro built a student information system to track crit on the program. Jim is heading off to Calgary to speak with Rotary clubs about getting inv Becas. Non Rotarians are now getting involved as well with examples cited such as sever lawyers from Manitoba and Calgary .

For the last three years the Saskatoon Rotary Club presented cheques at the PV univers the contributions in person to the students. Six years of sponsorship have resulted in grad students getting meaningful jobs or going on to higher levels of university education . 57 s have received scholarships to date.

Jim even recruited his PV Cab driver's son as a student and Becas recipient.

An eighty five percent average is needed to stay in the program and the Parents must co won't take kids out of school to work. The PV Rotary Club handles all cash to ensure the
