Under President Gary's fine leadership the Club conducted an impressive Club Assembly today with well prepared presentations from the following:

Mike LeClaire spoke on the RAP program. RAP may run a deficit next year as a result of Justice Funding being presently undetermined. This may change eventually in all sixteen high schools. Providing RAP on a fee for service basis is being explored. Cameco has expressed interest in our RAP training for its employees. A McConnell foundation submission is being prepared for additional RAP funding. Director Winston is presently engaged on a half time basis. City funding may also be modified to a "per school" basis as opposed to lump sum funding.

Dave Sundby presented on World Community service and listed progress on numerous valuable projects including the Guatemala school playground project.

Jim Weber is seeking used laptops), the Uganda Joy Home of Hope being spearheaded by Maureen Torr, the Tanzania water collection project being led by A Malawi project driven by Peter and Elaine Zakreski. In addition the Club is providing support to the Shelter Box program.

Jim Weber gave an update on the Rotary Foundation which is the largest of its type in the world. The RF Annual Programs fund allows a portion of funding to cc projects while the rest goes to world wide projects. The RF Permanent Fund is for permanent capital wherein only the earnings are gifted. The new goal is "ERI with a target of raising \$100 per year from each Rotarian. Paul Harris recognition is provided for every \$1,000 given. Our International President will be awarding event - further details to be announced.
