#### Guest Speaker

Peter Zakreski introduced long time Rotarian **Harold Empey**. Harold spent 40 years with Federated Coop starting as messenger and went on to become President of Corporate Affairs. He is the Oliver Lodge funding raising lead and a Rotarian for the past 54. He has received the Saskatoon Community Foundation award and the Queen's Jubilee medal along with many other awards.

Harold spoke on the topic of preplanning for the inevitable, death. Harold, who lost his wife in November and recently lost his son, realized that preparing in advance one can do for one's family. Harold has worked with the Saskatoon Community Foundation in developing a comprehensive binder entitled "Just in Case" that contains information the Executor and family members need to know in administering the death estate. These details also include many of the small decisions that it is important to minimize any family discord in a time of great stress. The twelve sections cover matters like contact lists, wills and banking information, celebrations of life, obituary and family tree details and many other important details.

He has now delivered his message over 700 people and has seen distributed over 470 binders at \$20 each. Harold receives no compensation. The price goes to the Saskatoon Community Foundation. He recommends that we start this planning early and not be afraid to speak to a Funeral Home for options and prices.
