Group Study Exchange: India

- · Jenn Sharpe & Allanah Scharfstein presented on their experience
 - o Jenn is the Assistant Editor at Bridges magazine
 - o Allanah is a Elementary School Band teacher at Egnatoff School
- · They were away for 4 weeks
- · This program started in the mid-50's
 - o Meant to encourage young professionals to broaden cultural horizons
 - o Thinking about changing to be more vocationally based in future
- · Newspaper in India is the primary means of communication
- Rotary sponsored many school supplies for classrooms
- · While visiting one of the classes, they were able to put a makeshift band together to play music with the kids
- Children actually need to pay to go to school
- · Large disparity in the country between those few above poverty line and those below it
- Clarified butter used heavily in their cooking
- · Overweight body types almost a sign of wealth
- Rotary Club sponsoring a housing project outside of Balghar
 - o Low interest loans
 - o Only trusted women with the loans
- · A main priority is vaccinating against Pollio
 - o $\,$ 1 year away from being off the endemic list
- · Jenn & Allanah did 5 different talks while there including 3 to Rotary Clubs
