Guest Speaker - Lt. Cmdr. Karen Wallace - Naval Reserve



Cmdr. Wallace holds and bachelor of science degree in mathematics from the U of S and commands the HMS Unicorn of the Naval Reserves, as part of the 17 HMS Unicorn was established in 1923.

Civilian members of the Reserve regularly attend the Dundum DND facilities and participate in maintenance exercises. Army, Navy and Air members are all act The Regular force and Reserve forces form the two components. The Reserves are typically part time. Maritime coastal defense is part of the Reserves obligati but both NCO's and Officers are expected to maintain their Naval training. There are four parts to the Reserves including Primary, Cadets, Rangers and Supplei achieve sailing certification while Rangers are aboriginal members stationed in the North to safeguard Canada's interests.


