Guest Speaker - Lt. Cmdr. Karen Wallace - Naval Reserve



Cmdr. Wallace holds a bachelor of science degree in mathematics from the U of S and commands the HMS Unicorn of the Naval Reserves, as part of the 17 HMS Unicorn was established in 1923.

Civilian members of the Reserve regularly attend the Dundurn DND facilities and participate in maintenance exercises. Army, Navy and Air members are all part of the Regular force and Reserve forces form the two components. The Reserves are typically part time. Maritime coastal defense is part of the Reserves' obligations but both NCO's and Officers are expected to maintain their Naval training. There are four parts to the Reserves including Primary, Cadets, Rangers and Support. Primary achieve sailing certification while Rangers are aboriginal members stationed in the North to safeguard Canada's interests.

3500 sailors joined the Reserves from the prairies and entered WW2. Both Rear Adm Yano and the head of the Royal Cdn Navy are from Saskatchewan. It is often said that prairies make the best sailors.

Canada has the longest coastline in the world, therefore Canada needs a navy. 90 Percent of the economy of the world floats on ocean and piracy is a major issue.

Key duties of HMS Unicorn have included domestic safety i.e. flooding assistance, fleet augmentation and domestic security for the Olympics. When the Memorandum of Understanding was signed, HMS Unicorn was its escort.

Cmdr Wallace oversees 70 people on her role, who all stand "Ready aye ready" !!


