# Elaine Zakreski on the Hope for Malawi Project:

Bev Dubois introduce our member Elaine to the Club. Did you know that...

- Elaine is a Holy Yoga instructor!!
- Graduated from U of S in Early Childhood Education
- Authored the book "Hope for the Journey" to assist single parents
- Has been married to Peter for 51 years!!
- They have four children

Elaine spoke passionately about the Hope for Malawi ("HfM") project. She shared the following facts about the many projects underway that both the Malawi Four Foundation are supporting:

- The Zakreski's have made five trips to Malawi
- To date \$100k has been raised by the HfM foundation with another \$300k raised by the Rotary Foundation
- The HfM project is comprised of 50 villages and 5 zones where organizing committee structures are set up
- The flight is 28 hour flights!! One whole suitcase is packed with soccer balls
- First project was a round school for 200 people
- The "Container of Love", donated from Sasktel was shipped with donations taken at the local Walmart, including desks, school supplies, st
- 18 people are on the HfM payroll at this time
- $\bullet\,$  lpad's for the schools is  $\,$  planned for the next trip...enough for every child in school
- Malawi has a British education system; therefore at grade eight level exams are required. Therefore the students need to know English whi
- Our Rotary club has donated lab equipment for malaria testing and other uses
- The HfM Clinic has thirteen rooms and is of very high quality
- Our previously supported Maize mill for soy fortified maize continues in full production
- Cattle production is part of the HfM process. A Canadian holstein organization attended and helped fix the cattle diet for weight gain
- The 11 water bore holes we've supported have saved many lives
- School classes even include a wood carving course
- The author of the "Hope for Malawi" book is now offering scholarships for children in villages
- A brick structure community and ed center was built during their recent trip
- 100 student classrooms are common with a typical 1 to 75 ratio
- Choir sponsorship and a cd record was another successful project
   2000 attended a "act half" to warment that the foundation appears
- 2000 attended a "net ball" tournament that the foundation sponsored

- \$15,000 was spent at Wallmart and included fleece jackets for the "go go grandmas", important elders in the community
- HIV is an ongoing issue for adults and children
- Peter and Elaine attended two rotary meetings on their last visit
- Peter teaching the locals to hug each which is not part of their culture
- A large Rotary park is being constructed
- The "Good Morning Malawi" tv program interviewed Elaine and Peter (see photo below) and is preparing a full documentary on the HfM proje
- Elaine concluded with "What we've done for them is a small thing...what they have done for Peter and I is a huge thing"!! **Thank you Elic dedicated service!!**
