Dan has served for 30 years in several different roles in the Fire department. He enjoyed many rewards in serving the community of Saskatoon during this period.

Emergency measures is in the forefront of his service role. He prefers the title of Fire and Protective Services as a good description of what he and fellow members of Saskatoon. This he views as a proactive rather reactive service. Many residents of Saskatoon appreciate that and often say "thanks".

Fire and Protective Services is now delivered out of 9 stations. Emergency services (ES) is a particular focus now. Every community in the city has an ES plan in question: "When things go awry, can you cope for 72 hrs?" - i.e. in the delivery of power, water, health etc.

Fire Service is also making good progress i.e. addressing fire frequency in suspect houses.

Thank you Dan for all that you and your dedicated team do in keeping our community and our property safe and protected.
