Joy Home of Hope

Bevintroduced our member Maureen Torr who was born in rural Uganda. At a young age Maureen went to live with her sister in the city to allow Maureen to see Unfortunately her sister passed away leaving Maureen to raise her many nieces and nephews, thus delaying her own schooling. Many years on, she is now en program at the U of S. Maureen is married to Dr. Torr and they have 6 children. They have also helped raise 69 other children in need in Africa.

Maureen spoke first about attending the Rotary conference in Lisbon where she practiced her Portuguese and French. The R.I. president's message this year i Lives." Over 35,000 people from 168 countries attended. A special guest speaker was the first Rotarian woman who joined Rotary, overcoming much oppositic future women to join. As well a disturbing presentation was made by a former child soldier from Uganda. A Liberian woman also made a presentation on the in African culture. Walking fours were also conducted in and around Lisbon.

Maureen then delivered inspirational comments regarding her "Joy Home of Hope" in Uganda. The new school, built from hand-made bricks, now has seven cl quarters. The windows and doors are now in. Approximately 100 children showed up on the first day!

Maureen shared the site plan that demonstrated a very impressive vision for a size of school property many times larger than the current buildings. A Rotary clu the provision of fresh water. The first phase carries a \$65,000 cdn budget for total costs. Donations are welcome.

Maureen is also asking for help in organizing a local fundraiser and is looking for someone to chair such an event. Please contact her if you would like to help c
