CoCoRaHS gives broader data and more accurate information across the Environment Canada weather sites. CoCoRaHS has also saved lives and was set up after severe flooding causing several deaths over 50,000 volunteers. 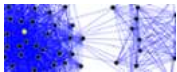
**ABOUT COCORAHS**
