Saskatoon Friendship Inn (SFI)



Speaking to the Club today were Angela Nimchuk and Sandra Stack, Volunteer Coordinators for the Saskatoon Friendship Inn. (Remember members your choweek, October 28, 2013 at the Friendship Inn, 619 20th Street West Saskatoon, SK, S7M 0X8, 306-242-5122)

Angela and Sandra presented us with the following valuable information about this much needed local service, which is guided by the following quote...

"If you cannot feed one hundred hungry people, then begin by feeding one." Mother Theresa

- Breakfast is served from 8:00am till 9:00am; SFI is currently serving around 200 people.
- · Lunch is served to Guests at 11:45 till 1:15 where SFI expects over 400 people to come and enjoy a warm nutritious meal.
- Without the help of daily volunteers & fine option program the Saskatoon Friendship Inn would not be what it is today
- Volunteers take time out of their busy schedules to come and help out within their community. Over the past year volunteers have saved t
 approximately \$200, 000 in wages.
- Programing & Activities:
 - Every Saturday an all ages Art Class.
 - Wednesdays
 Cribbage Tournament (1:00pm-3:00pm)
 Every Second Friday
 - Every Second Friday Mom and Baby Clinic (11:30am-1:30pm)
 - Thursday's Street Health & and Elder (10:30-1:30pm)
 - Both Men's & Women's Parenting Class
 - Anger Management Workshops
 - Monday-Friday a family worker provides referrals, long distance calls, and emergency supplies.
- 7 days a week from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. the SFI van is constantly picking up food donations from valued partners.
- SFI has beautiful food donations coming in, but one thing to remember is...they are all food orientated. Which is FANTASTIC, because tha revolves around, however that is not the only thing the Saskatoon Friendship Inn can run on. If SFI were to pay for everything needed to run Inn on a daily basis it would cost approximately \$5,000 per day.
- The SFI has categorized ways for service clubs to support the Saskatoon Friendship Inn as their Charity of Choice.
