RAP


Tim praised the Club for its RAP program and the recent mention by the Provincial Government of RAP as an important element in its newly announced anti bullying program.

Jeff is 29 years old and has spent much of his working career overseas. Jeff is a past Rotary Exchange Student and was invited to join our club by Gary Rusu. A graduate of Carlton University, Jeff spent four years on Parliament Hill as a journalist where he got to know many of the politicians, sharing with us some funny anecdotes about the "Duffster", Senator Mike Duffy. Jeff also focused on the area of National Defense.

An intriguing story told by Jeff involved his travels to East Africa where he was inadvertently arrested as a "suspected US spy". (Now there's a first for our Club!) He was able to talk his way free when he produced a copy of his Canadian Passport from his money belt. This experience subsequently led him into a charitable business venture in Kenya called "Stash Belt". In Kenya leather is their number 3 export. The hand made leather "Stash Belt" is a stylish money belt that also holds a small computer thumb drive for vital information. Production is now in the thousands with 10% of the profits going back into supporting small Kenya business start-ups. Jeff even recently pitched the "Stash Belt" idea to Brett Wilson!

Jeff is presently working in local journalism for such magazines as Chamber Business View, Verb and Canadian Press. He is also involved with 2webdesign in Saskatoon assisting businesses with marketing and branding on-line. (See www.2webdesign.com)

Heather Clysdale

Heather hails originally from Ontario where she grew up on a dairy farm. After completing University in Ontario, she was hired by PetroCan to come west and help run their operations in Western Canada. She met President Peter in Saskatchewan and was recruited by Peter to join Federated Coop in their significant petroleum division. Heather started off in the area of marketing, calling on the retail coop clients in the West. She then moved into the operations side of the business, overseeing several complex IT systems implementations for their trucking and Point of Sale operations. As with any conversion, the devil is in the details, including training the fleet of truckers on use of the new computer system. She reports that while there was some initial reluctance from those who were a bit technically challenged, the training was a success and she now has an army of converts to the new system.
