Club Business

Program

Nancy introduced Dorothy Hudson to everyone. Dorothy was here today to discuss their Ghana project. Dorothy has been a Rotarian for 23 yrs and was first attracted to Rotary because of its involvement in the eradication of polio. Dorothy has worked in Nigeria, Nepal, Tibet, Haiti and Guatemala. Dorothy gave us a brief overview of the project. Members from their club working on this project include Hannah Enti Brown, Asit Sarkar, Bob MacGillvary (treasurer), Jim Gillis (legal advice) and Dorothy Hudson.

Hannah, trained in Public Health, is originally from Ghana and has visited the community in Kalbeo Zenga in the Bolgatanga Municipality in the Upper East Region of Ghana where the project will take place.

Kalbeo has a population of about 1500 people. Sanitation is a challenge – residents must travel at least 2 km to get clean water. Due to lack of toilets, the residents need to use open latrines.

Contacts have been made (via Zoom) with the Rotary club of Bolgatanga to oversee the project.

The plan is to provide a high yielding borehole with a large polytank c/w a solar powered pump. There will be several fetch points for residents to collect water. There will also be 80 biofil microflush toilets with handwash stations installed. These toilets will then produce fertilizer which can be sold to local farmers to enhance their crop production.

Total budget for the project is estimated to be \$81,800.

They have applied to RI for a global grant. Money will also be raised from our local clubs and Rotarians abroad in Ghana, U of S, DDF and the World Fund.

Their local (Saskatoon) fundraising goal is \$14,000.

Sustainability: The local community in Ghana will contribute small regular fees for use. Income generating opportunities will be available from making and selling soap.

We thanked Dorothy for braving the cold to make this presentation to us and told her our Service Committee would discuss further how we might be able to contribute.
