Program

Dr. Tyler Wist provided members with an interesting perspective on “Aliens and Insects” or Science Fiction or Science Fact. Tyler is a Research Scientist-Field Crops Entomologist with Agriculture and Agri-culture Canada and is published in many scholarly and journalistic publications.

He introduced the topic by referring to the 1979 Movie, which blended insects with arachnids. While the characters were aliens, they were based on facts stolen from nature. The parasitic wasp injects its eggs into the refuse pile of a caterpillar, like the alien injected its eggs into a human.

There are two types of parasitoids – one that kills its host and one that doesn't. He showed how a wasp lays its eggs into a caterpillar, who multiply and then cut their way out of the caterpillar when mature and make a cocoon around the caterpillar, unless it can escape. Others make a small cocoon. Wasps also lay eggs in aphids, who then attach themselves to a leaf while the eggs mature, before it cuts its way out of the aphid. The wasps are also to control insects that attack crops.
