What is the Keep Them in School Foundation?

The foundation was incorporated in March 1993. The establishment of a fund to assist students in pursuing post-secondary education was a vision of former school trustee and prominent Transcona resident, Mrs. Mary Andrée.

The Foundation Board of Directors was comprised of business owners, school trustees, school division Superintendent and Secretary-Treasurer. Morley Waslenko, former TD Bank Manager, was the first Chairman of the Board. Among the first Board of Directors were former Police Chief Graeme Stewart, Frontier Toyota's Roger Tychnick, Thomas Copeland, Don Toyne, Dr. Michael Grace, School Trustee Mary Andrée, TSSD Superintendent Gerry Saleski, Secretary-Treasurer Todd Baraniuk and David George.

Fundraisers for the Foundation have consisted of airline ticket raffles, change boxes at businesses, dinners, grey cup tickets and its largest source of funds has been its annual golf tournament. Further funds have come from area businesses, and estates.

Today the fund manages eight endowed funds and multiple bursaries and scholarships totaling over \$15,000 per year given to students. In 2010 the foundation joined The Winnipeg Foundation, giving it additional access to administration support.

After nearly 20 years The Keep Them in School Foundation continues to grow and enhance its ability to help students continue their studies.
