The meal was followed by a fill-in-the-blank Valentine's Day game that produced some hilarious results! Everyone was a winner so each table received a box of chocolates.

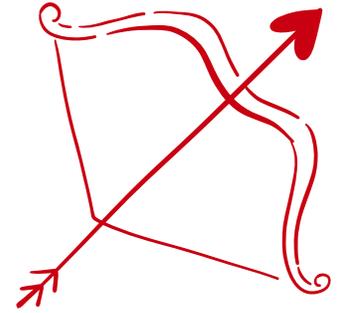
Irene asked that the cooks come out so that we could thank them for the great meal. They certainly deserved the round of applause that they received,

ROTARY TURNS 121

Rotary was founded in 1905 by Paul Harris, an attorney who settled in Chicago but found himself without friends or clients—and decided to start meeting with like-minded individuals to find solutions for his community.

First Meeting

- Paul Harris held the first Rotary meeting on February 23rd, 1905 with three other members: Gustavus Loehr (a mining engineer), Silvester Schiele (a coal broker), and Hiram Shorey (a merchant tailor). By the end of the year, Rotary Club One had grown to 30 members.

Origin of the Name

- The name Rotary comes from the fact that the meeting rotated from one member's office to the next, ensuring participants knew about each other's business and professional classification.



Adopting a Motto

- Although it existed in various forms, Rotary's motto of "Service Above Self" was officially adopted in 1950 as a way to communicate what Rotarian life represents.

Here at the Lakehead

- The Rotary Club of Fort William–Port Arthur was established on July 1, 1916. After a burst of growth, the Port Arthur members split off in 1924.
