LAST MEETING

The Club welcomed Linda Bruins representing “Evergreen United”, a “grass roots” organization formed to support children, youth and their families who reside in the community in the vicinity of Simpson and Ogden Streets. The organization is a not-for-profit with facilities located in “Evergreen House”, a former motorcycle gang clubhouse at 139 Heron St.

Evergreen United’s vision is “a United Neighbourhood is strong people living in a healthy and safe community” with the Mission “to enhance the capacities and mobilize the strengths of the people living in the Simpson-Ogden neighbourhood. Together we work to create a vibrant, prosperous, inclusive, resilient, healthy and clean community.”

Evergreen United focuses on programs feeding and building a strong neighbourhood by supporting young people in the area with art, volunteering and skill building programs. They offer a safe place for youngsters to meet, learn and grow.

The group is supported through funding from the City of Thunder Bay, the United Way, the District of Thunder Bay Social Services Administrative Board, the Ontario Trillium Foundation, Home Depot and individual donations.

They also partner with other groups providing complementary or supplementary services, including Our Kids Count, Dilico and the City of Thunder Bay.

Linda Bruins has been an integral part of the organization since it’s inception, starting with taking children to Minnesota Park as a neighbourhood “mom” to the children in the community. She described how proud she was that one of the early participants, having achieved a degree in University, was now fulfilling the role of the organizations Board Chair. Linda’s work has been recognized by the City of Thunder Bay and others as the organization has developed.
