

Zoom Meeting of April 22nd 2020

President Stephen welcomed everyone to the Club's second virtual meeting. There were nineteen members participating.

Irene Sottile gave the toast to the Queen. She also gave a toast to Rotary International for the organization's quick response to the COVID-19 crisis.

There was one piece of correspondence, which was a thank-you card that the club received from Matthew Wainwright. He is a third-year NOSM student who received a bursary from the Club.



David Knutson provided the House Lottery update. The radio ads should be running this week. David thanked all of the Rotarians who are manning the phones for the ticket sales.

President-Elect Cynthia Judge is leading the Club initiative to apply for District funding that can be used for COVID-19 disaster relief. In response to

a survey on the subject, club members voted for the funds to be split between Shelter House and RFDA. The funds available would be US\$1000.

The Canada Club held its first virtual meeting on Thursday, April 16. The calendar of events for the next Rotary year was reviewed. A volunteer is required to be the club representative for the Christmas Parade committee. If you are interested, please contact President Stephen.

Lakehead Rotary will be the lead club for the Peace Day Ceremony. They will also host the tri-club Christmas party. Port Arthur Rotary will be organizing the Rotary Foundation dinner. PARotary thanked everyone who responded to the survey after this year's dinner as it has provided valuable feedback for planning next year's event.



It was decided that all three Rotary Clubs would sponsor the Rotaract Club for next year. President Stephen suggested that all four clubs could work on a project together, such as a park cleanup. Each Club discussed their proposals for the District funds available for COVID-19 disaster relief.

The first virtual Club Board meeting was held on Tuesday, April 21. One of the items discussed was that the majority of Club members are interested in using e-transfers to pay dues. Treasurer Boris Cham will look into getting that organized.
