He joined badminton and experienced, first hand, the benefits of physical activity on mental health. He was inspired by a quote from Michelle Obama:

Ishaan believes that the groundwork of all happiness is good health. He has established team members of his Active Mental Health Initiative organization in Mississauga and Hamilton as well as Thunder Bay. He has organized a few fundraising events at each location.

Ishaan was interested in apps for mobile phones that could increase physical activity, rather than just recording it, as most of the current apps do. He held a student competition to inspire students to try their hand at developing apps that would accomplish this. Ishaan would like to recruit more people to join to ensure continuity of the initiative. He would also like to move the program into public schools to teach younger students about the concepts.
