Nobel Peace Laureate to speak at convention

Leymah Gbowee won the Nobel Peace Prize in 2011 along with Liberian President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf and Yemeni peace activist Tawakkol Karman, nominated for their "non-violent struggle for the safety of women and for women's rights to full participation in peace-building work." Gbowee, who had lived in a refugee camp, worked as a counselor for child soldiers and led a nonviolent peace movement that played a pivotal role in ending a bloody 14-year period of Liberia's civil war. 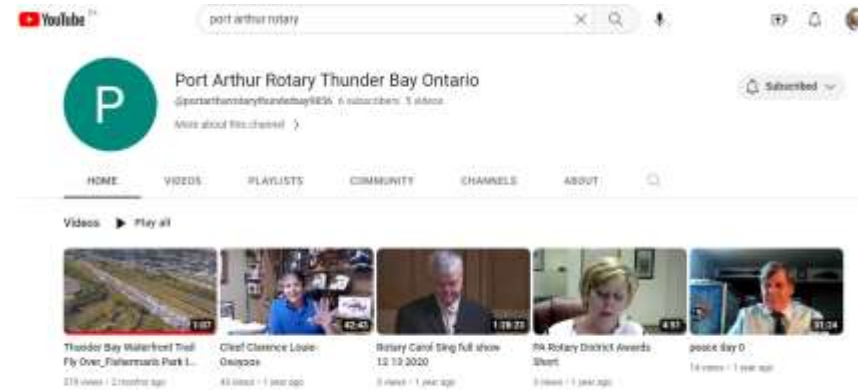
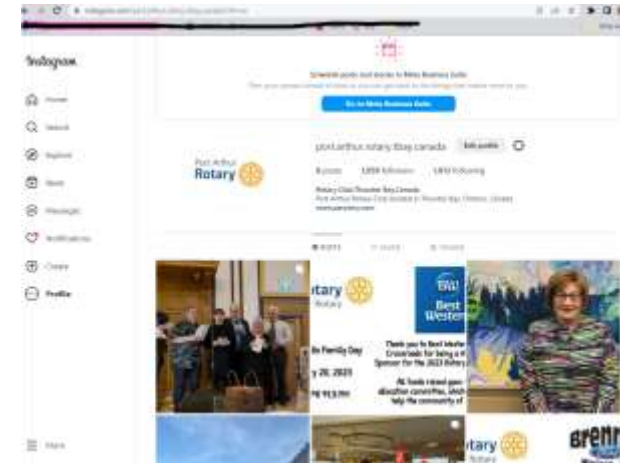
Bigger than polio

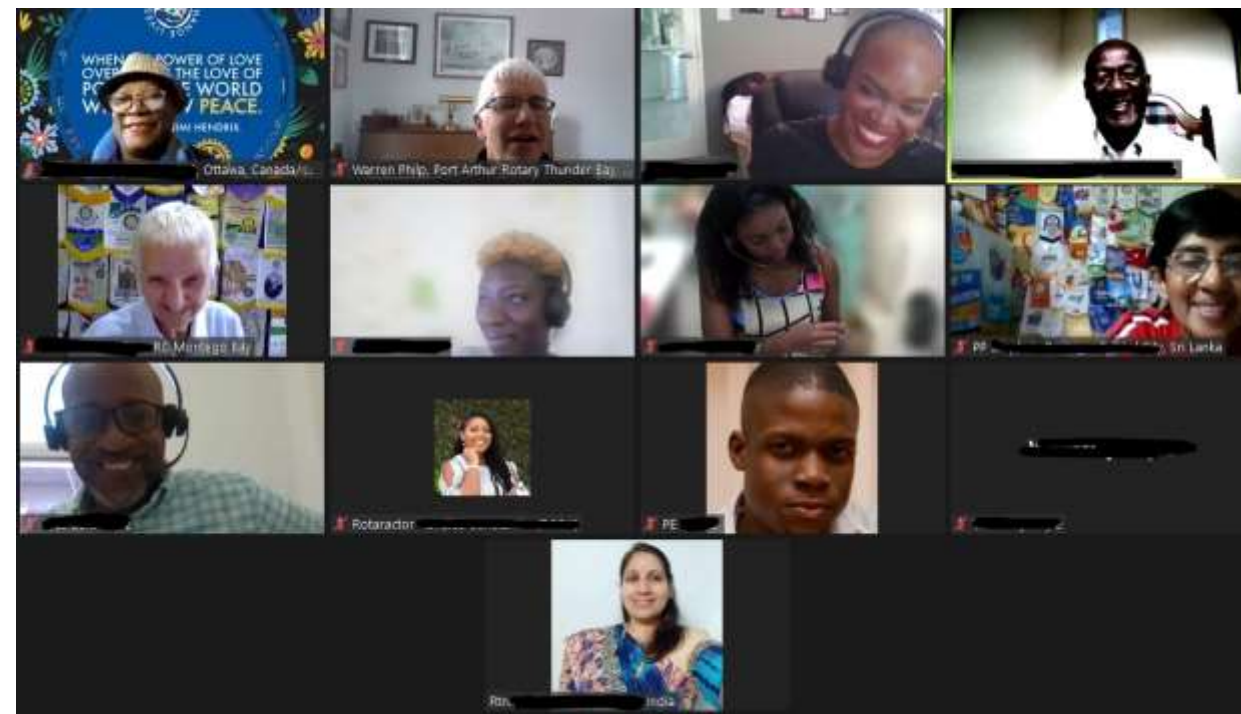
