



How to Play Rotary TV Bingo

Getting Started

To participate in Rotary TV Bingo, begin by purchasing your bingo ticket from any of the many supporting retailers. Each ticket costs \$6 and includes two playing cards.

Watching the Broadcast

Rotary TV Bingo airs on Tuesday nights from 7:00 to 8:00 p.m. on Wightman Channel 1. Tune in to watch and play along.

Gameplay and Prizes

During the broadcast, you will play five games with the following prize amounts:

- Game 1: \$100
- Game 2: \$200
- Game 3: \$200
- Game 4: \$300
- Game 5: \$500

The total jackpot for the evening is \$1,300. Use your bingo card for all five games during the current week only. Please do not use daubers until the fifth and final game, as your cards remain valid for each game throughout the night.

Claiming a Win

If you believe you have a winning ticket, call the Broadcast Studio immediately using the number displayed on the screen. If the line is busy or you do not receive a response, hang up and keep trying as there may be multiple winners for each game and only one phone line is available.

When you call in, you will be asked for the number in your card's free space. This number will be matched with those on the studio's computer to verify your win. It is important to note that multiple winners can occur for each game, and the prize for that game will be shared equally among them.

Receiving Your Prize

You can pick up your winning cheque by Friday of the week you play at the location where you purchased your ticket, or you may be contacted to arrange delivery. When collecting your cheque, please bring your winning ticket so that both the free space number and the ticket range listed on the outside of the ticket can be verified.

Important Reminder

The Ontario Gaming Commission restricts the playing of Bingo to individuals who are 18 years of age or older.
