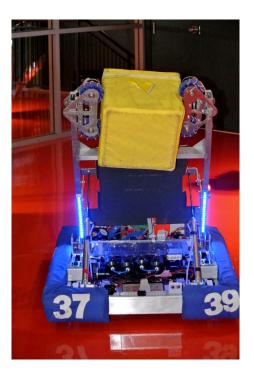

Prize Pelts

Considered one of the most beautiful furs, wolverine is a highly prized pelt, selling for an average of \$400 if in prime condition. Approximately 500 wolverine pelts are sold in Canada each year, over three-quarters of the coming from British Columbia. Nunavut, Yukon and the Northwest Territories. Wolverines are considered endangered in Quebec and Labrador, and "of special concern" in other areas west of Hudson Bay.
