This week, Rotarian Peter Tanner gave us an update on the Rachel Project - "Remote Area Community Hotspot for Education and Learning."

Peter and his committee are collecting used Android phones that will be cleaned and stripped of any information. These used phones will be sent to elementary schools in Guatamela to be used as reference resources by students. There will be local servers in the school with Wikipedia and other resources that the students can download onto these phones as their own personal reference books.

To do this, the schools must have electricity and wi-fi, but no internet connection.

Students will be taught to look up information they need rather than try to memorize it.

Peter talked about the numerous emails, the lengthy delays and the red tape in trying to get this project approved.

Our club is thankful for the hard work and patience that Peter has demonstrated. The project is worthwhile - and it is nearing completion.

Nikola will be staying with Laurie and Sparky for the first few months of her stay here in Chatham-Kent.


If you would love to share this experience or know any families (French speaking) that may be open to hosting Nikola, please contact Sparky.
