This week, our guest speaker was MPP Monte McNaughton, Minister of Infrastructure for the Province of Ontario. Monte was introduced by Rotarian Andy Watson who also served this area as an MPP.

Monte grew up in Newbury and by the age of 20 was already elected as a Newbury councillor. He was re-elected twice.

Monte and his wife, Kate, have a daughter, Annie. The family lives in Mount Brydges.

He graduated from Westervelt Business College in London and completed executive programs at the Richard Ivey School of Business at Western.

He became the new Minister of Infrastructure in June of 2018. This term is his third term as MPP for Lambton-Kent-Middlesex.

As minister, he has introduced legislation to expand natural gas availability to more rural parts of the province. He is also concerned with supplying hi-speed internet to rural parts of the province.



His government, with the urging of local MPP Rick Nichols, is committed to expanding Hwy. 401 to six lanes from Tilbury to London.

Monte oversees a riding that is larger than the entire province of PEI.

He recalled his early days in government when he served as a legislative page while in elementary school.

A major focus of his government is to reduce the \$347 billion debt that Ontario has amassed. To do this will require some difficult decisions for the Ford administration.

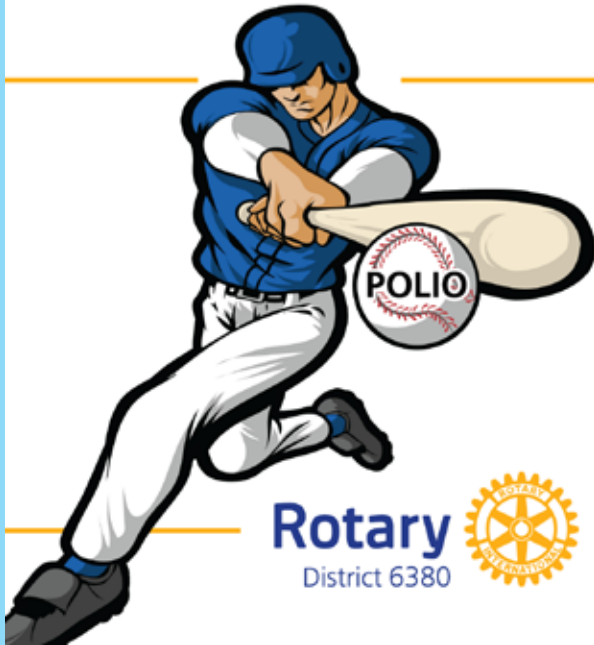
