

This week's speaker was Sandra Pidduck from the Chatham-Kent Family Health Team. Sandra was introduced by Rotarian Fannie Vavoulis. A family health team is a health care organization primary includes physicians, nurse practitioners, social workers, therapists, registered nurses, diabetes educators and other professionals. The CKFHT started in 2006 on Emma St. in Chatham and has grown to 5 locations, including Ridgetown, Wallaceburg, Dresden and Blenheim. There are over 180 family health teams in Ontario offering regular office hours and well as extended evening and weekend hours. The CKFHT has a staff of 110, including 30 physicians. Over 35,000 patients are on the roster. The health team is funded by the Ministry of Health. There is a great emphasis on programs and services at family health teams. Some of the programs offered are balance and mobility assessment, foot care services, Healthy You and Master



Your Health programs, Medication Therapy Management and many others. The CKFHT communicates with the public in many ways including booklets, website, social media and word of mouth. Family Health Teams seem to be the way of the future and we appreciate being updated by Sandra. Our thanks were expressed by **Rotarian Donna Litwin-Makey.**


