Junior Achievement has been in Chatham for the past 45 years. The CEO of the local Junior Achievement, **Barb Smith**, was our guest speaker this week. Barb was a participant in the programs while a student and has continued with JA for many years. She was introduced by **Rotarian Rick Bodnaruk**. Barb was born and raised in this area, attending the Pines and St. Clair College. JA is a non-profit international program dedicated to educating and inspiring young people about business and economics. It is primarily operated by volunteers and there are 200 volunteers in this area. The program starts in grade 5 with Our Business World, continues in grade 6 with Dollars with Sense and ends in grade 8 with Economics for Success. In high school, JA operates their signature program where students learn to run a business. They learn to incorporate and sell shares. Students produce and market their product or service and they try to make a profit for the shareholders. This year's business is producing silk-screened t-shirts (pictured) that are sold locally for \$15. The JA program relies heavily on volunteers and donors. The total funds needed annually are \$40,000. Youth who participate in the Junior Achievement program have the opportunity to gain insight and experience and we thank Barb and her volunteers for their dedication. 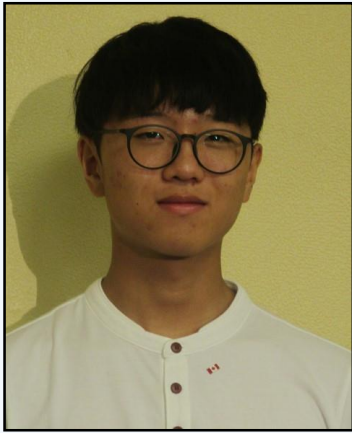

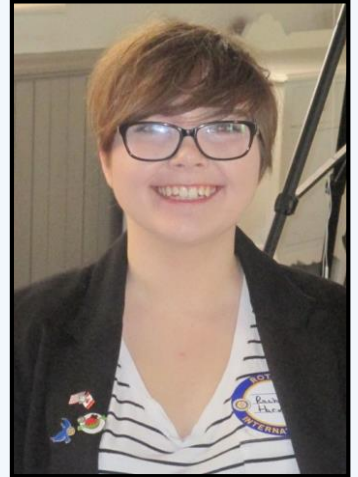
