

Roger is one of a bumper group of 3 Exchange students this year, a late participant at the ripe old age of 19. After an introduction by Colin McGregor, he gave a visual presentation of his home in Catalonia. The presentation following is heavily web-linked to allow you to follow his story. Click to view.

Roger was born in Ripoll and lived in Barcelona until the age of 5, at which point he, his parents and sister moved to a county environment in the town of Bordils. That's located in the north of Catalonia in the province of Girona, about equidistant (I hour) from the French border and the seacoast. The largest city is Girona(100,000) with the town 1,500. The population is clustered in the town centre, with many other living in country villas. The town has maintained its ancient appearance through building codes, and its ubiquitous church is typical – "From a bell-tower you can see a bell-tower, and so on."

Some of Roger's favourite places: <u>Cadaques</u> and <u>Costa Brava</u> on the coast; in the Balearics, <u>Menorca</u>; the famous convent at <u>Montserrat</u>; the <u>Pirineus Catalans</u>, Gaudi's work like the <u>Sagrada Familia</u> In Barcelona; and Salvador <u>Dali's</u> Museum.



Traditionally, Roger like the many festivals, <u>Castellers</u> in south Catalonia, the Christmas <u>traditions</u> featuring the <u>3 Kings</u>, the food! For example <u>Pa Amb Tomaquet</u> and the drink – he claims it's his DAD who does <u>Porro Catala</u>. Paul Mayrand described Roger's winding path to Chatham, and thanked him for the presentation.
