ORIGINAL CHARTER # 1011 issued - November 1st, 1921



This week's speaker was Steve Tultz from Leamington. Steve was introduced Rotarian Barry Fraser. Steve is a '75 graduate of OAC in Guelph and worked in the agricultural field for 40 years. He was plant manager for Green Giant in Tecumseh for several years. After retiring, Steve became active in the Gleaners program. He told Rotarians about this wonderful program, by volunteers, that provides operated dehydrated vegetables and fruits worldwide. Their name has a biblical connection and they operate on the principle that when harvesting your crop, you should leave some for the poor. Steve informed us that in our area, large amounts of food ends up rotting in the fields and going to the landfill. As an alternative, farmers are encouraged to give their excess fruit and vegetables to the Gleaners program. These donations are turned into a dehydrated vegetable soup mix and dried fruit that is shipped to Haiti, Bosnia, Zambia and other similar countries. All their finished product is provided free to local community partners and reputable social programs who help with distribution and shipping around the world. With millions starving, it is commendable



that these volunteers run such a program. It requires 35 volunteers to man the factory in Leamington. They operate every day from 8:30 until noon. Expenses such as heat and rent run about \$20,000 per month and these costs are covered by donations. Gregory Drive Alliance Church in Chatham is one of the partners in this program and helps to deliver the food. This is a wonderful example of cooperation between local farmers and local volunteers and we thank Steve for bringing it to our attention. Our thanks were expressed by **Rotarian Les Herman**.
