Our guest speaker this week was Greg Heatherington, general manager CKXS-FM, a local radio station which broadcasts adult contemporary music at 99.1 on the dial from Wallaceburg, Ontario. The station is owned by Five Amigos Broadcasting and began broadcasting in October 2009. Greg was introduced by Rotarian Carl Veroba who, as manager of CKSY in Chatham, hired Greg to be the morning host in 1989. He remained in this position for the next 20 years. After being granted a license from the CRTC, Greg and his partners hired six local people to start the new radio stations serving Wallaceburg and Dresden. Greg moved into the building in Wallaceburg where the station is located and started to sell ads as well as start the business. He is a great supporter of Wallaceburg and the local area. Greg described some of the obstacles he has faced and some of his



successes over the past 6 years. The station received a boost in the signal a year ago and is now broadcasting over the entire local community. Greg has worked hard supporting organizations such as United Way and Festival of Giving. He does a lot for the community and the community is returning the support. We wish Greg well with his station and our thanks were expressed by Rotarian Laurie Leonard.




## **Upcoming Tigers Baseball Game**
